

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Unpack the product and remove all packaging. Be careful not to scratch the surface of the product whilst removing the plastic wrapping. Lay the product out on the floor. If the floor is not carpeted, please cover it with a soft cloth to avoid damage to the flooring and surface of the product. Assembly should take place with the product lying flat. It may be necessary to remove protective packaging (plastic / cardboard) located at cable entry points of the product.

- 1. Screw the centre pole onto the upper lamp holder section. Keep the upper lamp holder section still and rotate only the centre pole to ensure that the cable does not twist. Hold both poles parallel whilst making the connection and if cross threading occurs undo and start again.
- 2. Screw the lower pole onto the centre lamp holder section. Keep the upper assembly still and rotate only the lower pole to ensure that the cable does not twist. Hold both poles parallel whilst making the connection and if cross threading occurs undo and start again.
- 3. Attach the base section to the assembled poles by carefully rotating into place. Ensure the parts are parallel and if cross threading occurs undo and start again. Rotate the base onto the assembled poles keeping the upper section still.
- 4. Gently pull any excess supply cable through the small hole in the lamp base until the base meets the assembled poles. Stand the floor lamp upright and ensure all the assembled parts are fully tightened.
- 5. Lightly loosen the small hex screws which hold the lamp arms in their transportation position. Gently swing the arms into their intended positions and re-tighten the hex screws on the using the hex key provided to secure the assembly in place.
- 6. Attach the shade, secure in place with the shade ring and fit the recommended bulb



Plug the floor lamp into the mains. Your floor lamp is now ready to use.

When positioning your floor lamp please handle with care.

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
