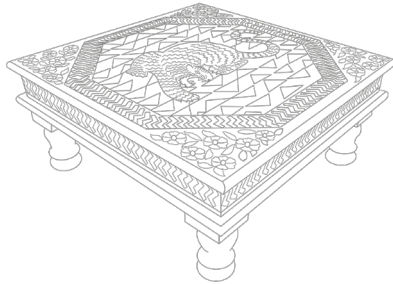

TIGRIS BAJOT TABLE

This small and decorative table has been lovingly handmade
and hand painted by artisans in Jodhpur, India
Due to this, each piece is unique and variations in colour and finish may occur

A Bajot table is traditionally used in India as a personal writing desk when seated on the floor

MANGO WOOD & MDF

The framework and legs are made from mango wood which is local grown and harvested in India
The tabletop is made from MDF

CARING FOR YOUR FURNITURE

During warm, humid weather wood can expand. During dry weather wood can
contract. These seasonal variations are a normal characteristic of wood

To keep your new furniture happy, make sure you keep it dry
Do not position in front of radiators or in sunlight and avoid direct heat
Similarly, do not place in moist environments or outside
Avoid light coloured surfaces

Take care when moving the furniture. Do not drag furniture as it may cause damage to the joints

Max weight 10kg
Ensure weight is evenly distributed
Take care not to overload
Do not sit or stand on the table
Keep away from fire
Be sure to use a coaster for your cup of tea

Not suitable for children's rooms
Domestic use only

CLEANING

Wipe with a damp cloth, followed by a soft dry cloth. Any spills should be
wiped dry immediately to avoid discolouration and staining

Avoid abrasive cleaners
