FRAMES

Our upholstered furniture ranges have oak or beech frames (see individual products for full details) and are individually hand built in the UK. The construction of the frame is guaranteed for 25 years from date of purchase.

Please note the filling, interliner, outer fabric, legs, accessories are not covered by this guarantee.

FABRIC

To finish our upholstered furniture, we use Designers Guild fabric. Designers Guild is a UK company with an unparalleled reputation for quality and choice. We also selected Designers Guild for its use of ecologically responsible, recycled yarns. All of our upholstery complies to UK Flammability regulations and is suitable for domestic use only. For contract work (e.g. hotels/businesses), they will need to be treated using a different method - please contact our dedicated Customer Service Team on 0208 9740110.

CARING FOR YOUR UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE

To ensure that your upholstered furniture is kept in pristine condition use a lint roller to pick up any fluff or marks that have been left. If you do this regularly, your upholstered product will remain in the best condition.

IMPORTANT: Velvet is inherently sensitive to pressure. Any marks left after scuffing or compression will come out given time, but this process can be helped along by lightly steaming the affected area. This is a natural characteristic of this type of fine fabric. It does not in any way, detract from its wearing ability.

NEVER use water to clean fabric – use a dry cloth to remove surface moisture. Always dab the affected area, do NOT rub.

It is always advisable to use a specialist upholstery dry cleaner. For best results with more stubborn stains, use a reputable specialist dry cleaning service.

Dust the wooden legs with furniture polish and a cloth.

Please be careful not to get polish on the fabric as this may cause staining. Do not drag your upholstery as it may damage the joints and mark your floor. Avoid sharp objects.

Indoor use only.
